OPTIONS FOR GENEROSITY

If you want to invest in the work of God happening through the community of Glenwood, there are a variety of options for giving.

- Checks and cash
- **Bank to Bank** If you would like to give on a regular basis, just call the church for a Vanco application. You can set up a direct transfer from your savings or checking account. This method has the lowest fee of our giving platforms aside from cash or checks.
- **Credit/debit card** Just click on Glenwood's website glenwoodlutheranchurch.org and you have two options. You can click the "donate" link which will take you directly to PayPal or you can click the "mural" link and that will give you the option of giving through the online Vanco. The online Vanco allows you to designate your gift so you can direct it to "general giving", "mural", "memorial", "flowers", etc... The online Vanco allows you to set up an automatic payment if you would like that option. The platform assesses a fee to use this credit card service and you may select to add this fee to your gift. Otherwise, Vanco or PayPal will simply remove it from the donation.
- You may also give directly **from an IRA account**, tax free if you're over 70 and a half! Please call the church for more information on this way to support the church.
- Also, you may want to include Glenwood in your **estate planning**. Please arrange an appointment with Pastor Chris to talk through what you might dream to do with a transformative gift through your estate planning.
